COMMUNITY NEWS - TSS SURVEY & MOSQUITO TREATMENTS

Thank you to all residents who completed their Tenant Satisfaction Surveys! Your feedback is invaluable, and our Navy partners are hard at work compiling all the data into a comprehensive report. This report will be the cornerstone of our action plan, driving continuous improvements to the services we offer. Stay tuned for exciting updates on our Facebook page and CD Monthly Newsletter as we roll out new projects across our community.

Mosquito treatments in our Maylor Point Community will commence this month and continue through the end of September. Our treatment plans include perimeter spraying to control the adult mosquito stage and the use of dunks in the storm water/drainage system to control the larval stage. We ask residents to remove all vessels containing water from the exterior of your home, empty wading pools after use, etc., as this will prevent mosquitoes from laying eggs in any stagnant water.

MAINTENANCE TIPS- LANDSCAPE TIPS

This month, our landscapers will begin inspecting and repairing irrigation systems. During startup, we often find that nozzles need repair or adjustment as they can be easily moved or damaged during the winter and spring seasons by foot traffic, vehicles, and mowers. Once startup testing and repairs are completed, if you find any irrigation nozzles spraying in the wrong direction or hitting your home or vehicles, please don't hesitate to call our Maintenance line at 360-447-5800, option 1, and we will get the nozzles re-adjusted.

At this time of year, the grass grows very quickly. We have electric lawn mowers and weed eaters available for free rental from our self-help desk located in the Maintenance Warehouse at 2372 Robin Street, between 1300hrs and 1700hrs, Monday to Friday.

All pet waste should be picked up and disposed of regularly. Pet waste is hazardous, will kill the lawn if left, and quickly becomes odorous and unpleasant for neighbors. We also ask that pet owners remember to 'scoop the poop' when out in the community and common areas. Thank you for keeping the neighborhoods clean and enjoyable for all residents.
