BBQ Safety: Please place grills at least 10 feet away from your home.

**Hammocks:** Freestanding hammocks are welcome! Just remember not to attach them to the structure of your home, as it's not designed to support swinging motion.

**Ongoing Projects:** You'll notice several improvement projects continuing throughout the summer. Please remind children to stay clear of construction areas, equipment, and materials for their safety. Let's make this a fun, safe, and memorable summer for everyone in the community!

# **MAINTENANCE TIPS**

#### **Optimize Comfort with Seasonal Fan Adjustments**

Adjusting your ceiling fan direction helps regulate your home's temperature. Simply flip the directional switch on your fan to ensure maximum comfort in every season!

- Summer: Set to counterclockwise for a cooling downdraft and improve airflow.
- **Winter:** Set to **clockwise** to generate an updraft, pushing warm air down and keeping your space cozy. This is especially helpful for homes with high ceilings or uneven heating.

A friendly reminder that our homes, like many in the Pacific Northwest, **do not have air conditioning.** While your thermostat may display a "cool" setting, it won't provide cooling in homes without AC. We'll be sharing helpful tips to beat the heat this summer!
