COMMUNITY NEWS

To help everyone enjoy a safe and relaxing season, we'd like to share a few friendly reminders:

- AC Units: Portable style units only. Window mounted AC are not permitted.
- **BBQs:** They must be used at least 10 feet from any structure. Do not leave them unattended, and dispose of coals properly when finished.
- Gazebos: Decorative, free-standing types only, and no tarps allowed.
- Marijuana: Not permitted on federal property.
- **RV/Boat Parking:** It is not permitted. There is a 4-hour limit for loading/unloading only. For special circumstances, contact the office for ETP consideration.
- Vehicle Maintenance: Not allowed on property- this includes washing your car.
- **Trash:** Bins should be out by 6 PM the day before pickup and returned by 6 PM on trash day. The lids must be closed. No items may be left out at the curb. Please dispose of unwanted items at the Island County dump.
- Patios & Covered Porches: Please keep patios and porches tidy and clutter/trash-free.


