COMMUNITY NEWS

We are committed to improving our community and providing the best possible living experience for all residents, and we continue to roll out projects across our community. Here's what is happening in October:

- **Crescent Harbor II:** Vinyl siding replacement project, door painting project, gutter installation project Siding work is complete, painting and gutters ongoing.
- Roof Moss & Gutter Cleaning: With the roof anchors now installed, work on the Victory Park and Terrace homes has begun. Crescent Harbor III and Maylor Point will receive their second treatments.
- Maylor Point, OPQ Neighborhood: Lighting and hardware upgrade project for homes on Mountain, Rainier, Cascade, Baker, Mt Erie & Crater Loop.
- **Puget Sound Energy LED Project:** Installations are ongoing in vacant units, and work will start on Mountain Circle. This exciting zero-cost project will improve energy efficiency in our homes.
- Rockhill Terrace: Fencing project underway on Sandstone Drive.
- Wood Rot Repairs: Will be starting in the Forbes Point neighborhood in Maylor Point.

MAINTENANCE TIPS

As colder weather approaches, please remember to turn off the water at the outside faucets and disconnect all exterior hoses.

- Each exterior faucet should have a spigot cover attached, which you can pick up for free at our Self-Help Center located in the Maintenance building at 2372 Robin Street.
- To use the cover, place it over the exterior spigot and secure it using the attached elastic pull handle. These covers help prevent pipes from freezing.

Additionally, furnaces will soon be activated as temperatures continue to drop. Now is a great time to replace your furnace filters, which can also be picked up for free at our self-help store.
