School will be out this month, and with the lighter nights and warmer weather, we can expect to see more children playing outside in the neighborhoods and communal areas on the property. **Please slow down when driving through the neighborhoods and help us make sure all our families have a safe and enjoyable summer.**

For safety reasons, the following items are not permitted:

Wading pools over 12 inches in height, Hot tubs,

Swimming Pools, Fire pits, Trampolines are not permitted. Wading pools less than 12 inches and bounce houses are not permitted in communal areas/shared spaces, backyard use only, and should be monitored by an adult at all times.

Please remember to place BBQ grills at least 10 feet from the house.

Free standing hammocks are permitted. Do not attach hammocks or swings to the structure of the home as structural pillars and fences are not designed to support the swinging motion.

These guidelines are in place to help protect both residents and property, and to ensure that everyone can enjoy the summer months comfortably and safely.




Residents can expect to see many of our projects roll out and continue through the summer months, so it will be a busy time throughout the neighborhoods. Please remind children to be mindful of heavy plant machinery, construction barriers and construction materials on site, as we continue to improve our neighborhoods.

AC UNITS: PORTABLE STYLE ONLY. WINDOW MOUNTED AC ARE NOT PERMITTED.

Our homes, like many throughout the Pacific Northwest, do not have air conditioning. While your thermostat may have a "cool" setting, this is standard, generic labeling and will not provide cooling in homes without AC. We'll be sharing helpful tips and ideas for staying cool this summer through our usual channels, stay tuned!

Date: Saturday, June 27th

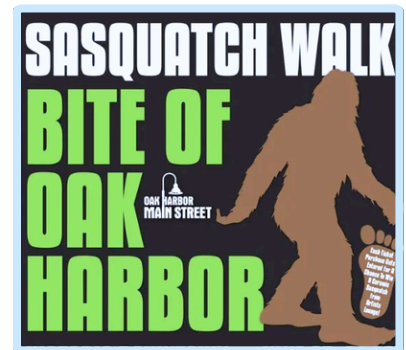
Time: 1:00 PM – 4:00 PM
